APRIL GUEST SPEAKERS

GEN. (RET.) JOHN TILELLI

Gen. John H. Tilelli, Jr. retired Jan 31, 2000 from the U.S. Army after over 30 years of service. His last active-duty assignment was Cmdr-in-Chief of the UN Command, Republic of Korea/U.S. Combined Forces Command/U.S. Forces Korea.

In Korea, he commanded the largest joint and coalition force in the world. In addition, he served as:

Vice Chief of Staff of the Army and the Army's Deputy Chief of Operations; Cmdr of the 1st Cavalry Div, Fort Hood, TX; deployed, trained & fought with the Division in Operation Desert Shield and Desert Storm.

Upon retirement, was appointed as Pres & CEO of the USO Worldwide Ops. Now employed with Cypress Int'l Inc. in Alexandria, VA as Chair & CEO – Emeritus. He served as the former Vice Chair for Korea Defense Veterans Assn & is currently serving on the KDVA Council of Advisors.
